#### Introduction:-

One of the important core missions of the College is to prepare the students to meet the contemporary business challenges and compete in the global economy to achieve this, students are required in this context, it is felt necessary to develop academic collaboration between universities and institutes. Academic collaboration programs between the universities and institutions are aimed at meeting the rapidly growing educational needs by leveraging mutual capabilities. These collaboration programs contribute to that goal by giving students and faculty members a higher perspective and better exposure in the area of global education.

With this backdrop, Augustine's College, Manoharpur agrees to enter in to an MOU with Govindpur College, Govindpur, Dist-Cuttack, Odisha and the same will cover the following:-

1. Exchange of teaching assignments:-

There will be faculty exchange between two institutions. The faculty members will prepare necessary lesson plans and incorporate pedagogical tools and other inputs like case studies, industrial Experiences etc. which will be discussed in the faculty councils of other institute before commencement of the sessions. The session plan will be finalized and same will be approved by respective HOD/Dean/Director/Principal. Besides, the faculty members of the partner institution will share teaching assignments depending upon the requirements.

2. Research and Consultancy Collaboration:-

Faculty members of both the institutes will Collaboration for joint research programs and apply approval of projects under shames offered by the central and state government. The resources will be shared between the two institutions and will aim at developing qualitative a quantitative research works. It will be a rich learning experience for the faculty members and go a long way in enhancing their proficiency in research. It will also be of immense benefit for industries in addressing their day today issues.

## 3. Collaboration for EDP & MDP:-

Both the institution will aim at conducting need based Faculty Development Programs (FDPs) and Management Development Programs (MDPs) to address the training needs of various industries and educational institutions at higher education levels. They will jointly explore for resources and grants to facilitate effective conduct of the FDPs and MDPs. The funds obtained for the above will be shared by the faculty members and the institutions in a pre-determined proportion.

4. Exchange of Library Resources:-

The facilities available in the libraries of the institutions will be accessible to faculty and staff members of both the institutions including E-library, National & International journals and other print and electronic data bases. They will be governed by the stipulated rule and regulations of both the libraries. This exchange will not only help the faculty member but also the students, who will be exposed to a broad based collection of library resources for their internship, projects and dissertation works.

## 5. Students Exchange:

Where ever possible, a selected group of Students can visit other institution for attending important classes, seminars, guest lectures, College meets etc. and can take the advantage of valuable input from the above events. This will be a substantial exposure for the students of both the institutions in the areas of curricular, co-curricular and extracurricular activities.

# 6. Collaboration for organizing National and International Seminars, Conference and Guest Lecture:

Both the institutions will collaborate for organizing National and International Seminars, Conference and workshops and guest lectures. At least one international and one National level seminar will be organized in an academic year with joint collaboration.

# 7. Collaboration for organizing College Meets:

Both the institutes will join together organizing College Meets by utilizing the best available in-house facilities and by involving students and faculty members.

### 8. Conduct of Job Fair:

The Training and Placement Cells of the Institutes will join together for organizing job fairs. The existing and pass out students of both the institutions will be able to get maximum exposure to placement opportunities.

- 9. Skill Development Programs: Both the institute will join together in organize training programs for the students on emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.
- 10. Future, we will extend the areas of collaboration for strengthening the academic excellence.
- 11. Financial Commitment: There is no financial commitment on the part of both the institutions and if there is any financial consideration, if will be dealt separately.
- 12. Validity: This agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either part on mutually agreed terms.
